

BEARDSLEY STUDENT MEAL INFORMATION

The Beardsley School District uses “Power Lunch”, a computerized accounting system for breakfast and lunch purchases. If you have questions concerning our breakfast or lunch program, please call your child’s school and ask for the cafeteria and we will assist you.

BORROW POLICY:

A borrow limit of **\$20.00** will be given to all full paying students. If a student reaches this limit their parent’s/guardian’s will be notified by phone that their child will **need to bring a lunch from home** the following day and until their account is no longer in the negative. Parents/guardian’s are expected to repay all amounts borrowed in a timely manner. Failure to do so may result in student report cards or diplomas’ being held until a payment is received. All negative balances **must be paid** by the end of the school year.

PAYMENT FOR MEALS:

It is the **parents/guardians responsibility to insure that their child has sufficient funds** in their account to cover all meals. A reminder slip will be sent home as a courtesy, when a student is out of money. In addition, students will be verbally notified when their account is out of funds.

Students are expected to pay money either before school, or during their first recess. Money can be added to your student’s account at **no charge** with a credit or debit card by using our **RevTrak** webpage. A link to this page is available at **Beardsleyschool.org**. All deposits made through RevTrak will be deposited into your student’s account the following school day. Account balances can be viewed in RevTrak and all funds are kept on the student’s account until used. Checks are payable to “**Beardsley School District**”. Checks returned for “non-sufficient funds” are subject to any fees incurred by the district. The District reserves the right to refuse any checks from accounts with an “NSF” history.

LUNCH CARDS:

Each student is issued a lunch card at the beginning of the school year, or upon enrollment. Students are responsible for keeping this card in good working condition. Students may obtain a new card by paying \$4.00 for a replacement. K – 5 grade students are **required** to have their card for lunch, if not they will need to purchase one.

FREE/REDUCED PRICE MEALS:

Applications for free or reduced price meals are available at your school office, or from the cafeteria. Applications are approved according to guidelines established by the State of California. All approved applicants are subject to audit, and must provide proof of eligibility upon request. Failure to provide such proof will result in benefits being terminated.
